

Enjoy the Retro Experience by Bus Moji Port & Shimonoseki Retro Map

The port of Moji and Shimonoseki still retain the retro townscape of yesteryear. Great for a leisurely stroll, or a detailed tour. Enjoy taking in the unique streets where old and new buildings stand side by side.



A Former Akita Shokai Bldg.
This unique building was completed in 1915 and represents the modern history of Japanese architecture, being a blend of western and Japanese styles. The steel framed reinforced concrete building has three stories and a basement, a tower and a Japanese garden and tea house on its roof.

B Shimonoseki City Aquarium Kaikyokan

Plenty of things to see here including Japan's largest penguin display facility "Penguin Village" and a unique area which features 100 different types of puffer fish (or fugu, Shimonoseki's specialty) from around the world. The variety of events available includes dolphins and seals performing together.



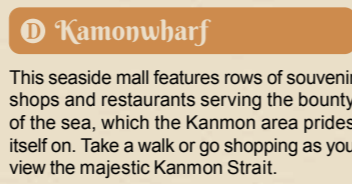
K Kaikyo Dramaship
This museum built in the shape of a dramatic ship brings you the history, culture and nature of the Kanmon Strait. The Kanmon Strait Atrium brings you the image of the seabed, and the latest technology brings you a dynamic insight into the history of the Strait.



C Former British Consulate in Shimonoseki
This precious piece of architecture was built in 1906, and offers an insight into a Consulate during the Meiji Era. It is the oldest remaining Consulate building in Japan, and was designated as an Important Cultural Asset in 1999.



F Mojiko Retro Observation Room
The observation room is on the 31st floor of the high-rise apartment building Retro Highmart, designed by the renowned architect Kurokawa Kisho. From this spot you can take in the views of the Kanmon Strait and the Mojiko Retro Town.



D Kamonwharf
This seaside mall features rows of souvenir shops and restaurants serving the bounty of the sea, which the Kamon area prides itself on. Take a walk or go shopping as you view the majestic Kanmon Strait.



B Kaikyo Yume Tower
This Kanmon Strait landmark tower was opened in 1996. From the 360 degree panoramic view from the 143m viewing deck you can see the Seto Inland Sea, Kammon Strait, Ganryu Island and the Sea of Japan.

G Former Mitsui O. S. K. Line Bldg.
This building is a reconstruction of the original Mitsui O. S. K. Line Moji branch. You can't miss the octagonal tower and the bright orange walls. There is a gallery on the first floor and the Kaikyo Roman Hall (multipurpose hall) on the second.



I Former Moji Mitsui Club
This historical building was constructed in 1921 as a social meeting place for Mitsui Bussan. The first floor has a restaurant and event hall, and the second floor features the Einstein Memorial Room and a room dedicated to the writer Hayashi Fumiko.



J Kyushu Railway History Museum
This historical redbrick building was constructed in the Meiji Era. Displays include real train carriages and railway cultural heritage. Outside there is a facility where you can try your hand at driving a train, a large panorama of a model train, and other displays where you can have fun while learning about railway history.

H Idemitsu Museum of Arts, Moji
The company Idemitsu Kosan was founded in Moji. The company founder, Idemitsu Sazo, collected eastern/Japanese ceramics, calligraphic works and paintings which are on display in the museum. The adjoining Idemitsu Historical Archives introduces the life of Idemitsu Sazo and the history of Idemitsu Kosan.
